

BRIDFORD PARISH COUNCIL

Applications are invited from persons interested in being considered for the Casual Vacancy which has arisen on Bridford Parish Council.

A parish Councillor must be:

- **A British Citizen**
- **Eighteen years or older on the day they are nominated**

For the whole of the twelve months prior to nomination they must:

- **Have been an elector of the parish and either occupied or owned/rented premises in the parish, or**
- **Resided within three miles of the boundary of the parish, or had their principal or only place of work in that area**

A person cannot apply if they:

- **Are the subject of a bankruptcy restriction order or interim order**
- **Have, within five years before the date of nomination, been convicted in the United Kingdom of any offence and have had a prison sentence (whether suspended or not) for a period of over three months without the option of a fine.**
